Mountain View Humane receives a \$30,000 subsidy from the Montgomery County Board of Supervisors to spay/neuter cats

(Christiansburg, VA) — Mountain View Humane Spay Neuter clinic located at 53 B. West Main St in Christiansburg, is offering \$1 cat sterilizations for any trapped cat living in Montgomery County thanks to funds provided by Montgomery County. Additional discounts are offered making outdoor cats in carriers \$11 and house cats are \$30. Call (540)382.0222 for details.

“This is a really good offer and one that will end when the subsidy run out,” says Kelly Cass, Mountain View Executive Director. “The Board of Supervisors approved this pilot project to begin addressing the pet overpopulation in Montgomery County. We really want to see pet owners take advantage of these greatly reduced spay/neuter surgeries for not only their community but for the health of their animals. It’s been proven that a spayed or neutered pet lives an average of 2 years longer.”
