Montgomery County, Virginia – Montgomery County’s Board of Supervisors has named L. Carol Edmonds as Interim County Administrator. Her new position will become effective March 14.

“We are pleased we can call on Carol’s considerable financial expertise and 15 years experience with the County to help guide the FY2010 budget process and handle administrative duties over the next few months,” said Board Chair Annette Perkins. “The County is in good hands while the Board conducts its search for a new administrator.”

Edmonds has worked in state and local government for 30 years. She began her career with the County as Director of Finance in 1994 and was named Assistant County Administrator in April 1997. She previously served as senior budget analyst for the Virginia Department of Planning and Budget and management consultant with the state Department of Information Technology.

Edmonds has a master’s degree in public administration with a concentration in executive management from Virginia Commonwealth University. She earned her undergraduate degree from Radford College.

Current County Administrator B. Clayton Goodman III will depart March 13 for the top position in Roanoke County.
