



COUNTY REAL ESTATE, PERSONAL PROPERTY TAXES ARE DUE DEC. 7

Montgomery County, Virginia –The second payment (2009-B) on Montgomery County real estate taxes is due on Monday, Dec. 7, 2009. In addition, the 2009 personal property taxes and 2010 motor vehicle license fees are also due Dec. 7.

Payment may be made in person or mailed to the Treasurer's Office at the Montgomery County Government Center, 755 Roanoke St., Suite 1B, Christiansburg, Va., 24073 or online at www.MontgomeryCountyVa.gov/treasurer. MasterCard and Visa are accepted at the office. MasterCard, Visa, American Express, Discover and eChecks are accepted online. There is also a drop-off box off the Chinquapin Trail entrance at the Government Center for your convenience. Do not put cash in the drop box.

Contact the Treasurer's Office at 382-5723 if you have not yet received your tax bill. A 10 percent penalty will be charged if not paid by Dec. 7, 2009. Interest will be charged at the rate of 10 percent per year beginning Jan 1, 2010. Only the postmark applied by the U.S. Postal Service to tax remittance envelopes will be used to determine timeliness of mailed payments.
