Montgomery County, Virginia –The open air burn ban has been lifted for Montgomery County. Residents should call the Sheriff's Office prior to burning so fire personnel will not respond when it is not necessary.

The countywide burn ban went into effect July 5 for the protection of property and lives. Thanks to all who have postponed outdoor burning until there was adequate rain.

Residents located in and around wooded areas should use extreme caution. Fire spreads rapidly and can consume a significant area in a very short time.
