Montgomery County, Virginia – The Montgomery County Voter Registrar’s office reminds citizens of important dates for voters and advises them to verify the information on their registration card by visiting www.sbe.virginia.gov. Please see the list of dates below:

Oct. 17 – Last day to register to vote in the general election

Nov. 1 – Last day to request an absentee ballot by mail

Nov. 5 – Last day to vote absentee in person

Voters in districts that have been affected by changes due to redistricting will be receiving new voter information cards. The Registrar’s office and the Virginia State Board of Elections have begun sending cards to affected voters this week. All voters in Montgomery County needing cards should receive them by the middle of next week.

If a voter’s information has not changed – such as the polling place or election district – then the voter may not receive a new voter information card. However, many voters without changes will receive a replacement card.

If a voter receives a new voter information card, the voter should destroy his or her old card. This new voter information card will replace the voter’s prior card.
