WORK SESSION

- Social Services PRIDE position -- request amended to fund part-time position
- FY2013 proposed budget – update on estimated local revenues and budget deliberations at the General Assembly. The Board also cancelled its special meeting April 16 to delay voting on the proposed budget and tax rate increase until its April 23 meeting or a later date after the state budget details become clearer.
