The Board of Supervisors adopted a FY2012-13 \$163.3 million budget. The budget includes a real estate tax rate of 87 cents per \$100 assessed value (an increase of 12 cents) and \$91.97 million for school operations. The new real estate tax rate will be reflected in June 5 bills.
