APPROVED BUDGET HIGHLIGHTS

FISCAL YEAR 2015

MONTGOMERY COUNTY'S APPROVED BUDGET TOTALS \$171.5 MILLION, A \$4 MILLION INCREASE OVER THE FY14 BUDGET OF \$169.7 MILLION

Montgomery County's approved FY2015 budget focuses on two important priorities: public education and public safety.

The FY15 spending plan of \$171.5 million, represents a 2% increase over the current fiscal year. Of the \$4 million increase in next fiscal year's budget, \$2.5 million in expected additional state funding goes to the schools. The budget also provides mandatory added funding for the increasing numbers of inmates held at the Western Virginia Regional Jail.

There are no new taxes in the approved FY2015 budget.


The real estate tax rate will hold steady at 89 cents per \$100 assessed value. Personal property taxes also will remain the same at \$2.55.


