## PRESENTATION

## WORK SESSION

Montgomery County Public Schools' (MCPS) request for \$2.5 million to cover costs of relocation of Blacksburg High School, Blacksburg Middle School and offices and facilities from the old Christiansburg Middle School.

## ADDENDUM

The Board voted 6-0 to support using \$1 million from the MCPS FY10 operating fund surplus and \$1.5 million from surplus capital bond funds for the schools to cover the costs of relocating schools and offices due to the Blacksburg High School gymnasium roof collapse.
