A closed meeting was held in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act for discussion or consideration concerning prospective appointees: Adjustment and Appeals Board, Board of Zoning Appeals, Community Services Board, Library Board, NRV Planning District Commission, Transportation Safety Commission and Workforce Investment Board Youth Council.

DELEGATIONS
