CLOSED MEETING - No votes taken or announcements made

A closed meeting was held in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act for discussion or consideration concerning a prospective business or industry where no previous announcement has been made: Project #2011-019. Discussion or consideration of the disposition of real property: old Elliston Fire Station and request by VDOT to acquire property for I-81 widening. Discussion or consideration of prospective appointee: Parks and Recreation Commission.

WORK SESSION

Courtney Rogers of Davenport & Company provided an analysis of proposed school capital projects on the County's debt capacity and debt affordability.

PUBLIC HEARINGS

- Special use permit – James and Lorilee Tannahill -- approved 6-0.
- Comprehensive Plan amendment to add a policy map designation and supporting language for proposed Urban Development Areas to comply with the Code of Virginia.
- Comprehensive Plan amendment to incorporate the 177 Gateway Area Plan into the existing Route 177 Corridor Land Use Plan.
- Ordinance amendment incorporating new zoning districts entitled Planned Unit Development Traditional Neighborhood Design (PUD-TND) and Traditional Neighborhood Design Infill (TND-I) and amending Residential Districts R-2 and R-3 to incorporate traditional neighborhood design concepts.
- Ordinance amendment deleting requirement that planning and zoning matter applicants post a placard notifying citizens about the public hearing continued to June 27.
