- Resolution requesting the Planning Commission to consider an amendment to the Zoning Ordinance increasing the size of political signs from 12 sq. ft to 32 sq. ft. and directing the Zoning Administrator to send a letter to all political candidates advising them that while this change is being considered the County will allow the use of political signs up to the 32 sq ft proposed limit.
