The closed session portion of the meeting shall begin at 6:00 p.m., if closed session is required, or at a time prior to or after 6:00 p.m. as notified by the County Administrator, otherwise the meeting shall begin at _____ p.m. in the Board Room of the Montgomery County Government Center, 755 Roanoke Street, Christiansburg, Virginia provided that when the regular meeting day of any month falls upon a legal holiday, such regular meeting in such month shall be held on the following business day; and provided further, that the Board of Supervisors may, by resolution at any meeting, provided that the next following regular meeting shall be a different time or place, and it shall then be the duty of the County Administrator to give timely notice thereof to all members of the Board and to inform the news media.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That should the Chairman declare that the weather or other conditions are such that it is hazardous for members to attend the regular meeting, the regular meeting shall be continued to the following Monday. The continuance of the regular meeting shall be communicated to the members and the press as promptly as possible.

ISSUE/PURPOSE: The Board is required to assemble at an office building owned by the County or such other public place as the governing body may prescribe at regular session not less than once each month.
