**A. SUBJECT: REZONING AND SPECIAL USE PERMIT
NRVP&P LLC PROPERTIES**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING CLASSIFICATION
OF APPROXIMATELY 0.473 ACRES, FROM AGRICULTURAL (A1) TO
GENERAL BUSINESS (GB) TAX PARCEL NO 90-5-40 AND
THE GRANTING OF A SPECIAL USE PERMIT TO ALLOW
A RECYCLING FACILITY ON APPROXIMATELY 4.442 ACRES
TAX PARCELS NOS. 90-4-1A, 2A, 90-5-1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 90-5-40, 40A AND 40B;
LOCATED AT 3431 RADFORD ROAD, CHRISTIANSBURG, VA
NRVP&P LLC PROPERTIES**

BE IT ORDAINED, By the Board of Supervisors of Montgomery County, Virginia that it hereby finds that the proposed rezoning and special use permit request is in compliance with the Comprehensive Plan and meets the requirement for public necessity, convenience, general welfare and good zoning practice and therefore approves the request to rezone approximately 0.473 acres of tax parcel 90-5-40 from Agricultural (A1) to General Business (GB), and the granting of a Special Use Permit (SUP) on approximately 4.442 acres, tax parcels Nos. 90-4-1A,2A, 90-5-1,2,3,4,5,6,7, 90-5-40,40A and 40B in a General Business (GB) District, with the parameters of the rezoning and SUP all shown more particularly on the attached Exhibit Plat entitled "Exhibit 7A-Lot Line Adjustments Map NRVP&P LLC Properties Montgomery County, Virginia, dated December 2, 2014", prepared by Draper Aden Associates, to allow a recycling facility subject to the following conditions:

1. The operation of the Recycling Center shall be in accordance with the provisions of the Zoning Ordinance. This permit shall automatically expire if the business ceases to operate for a period of two years or more per Section 10-54(3)(j)2.
2. The applicant shall obtain the appropriate commercial entrance permits and approvals from the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) and provide a copy to the County staff.
3. Hours of operation shall be limited to 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Saturday.
4. All collection and storage of materials shall be conducted inside the building identified as 3431 Radford Road.
5. At all times, the property shall be kept free of litter and devoid of loose materials from the recycling operation.
6. The applicant shall not accept or process any municipal, commercial, industrial, medical, or hazardous solid waste, as defined by the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ).

7. The applicant shall not accept or process any material, the disposal of which would violate applicable federal or state laws, rules, regulations, permits or requirements in effect at the time or place of disposal.
8. A site plan shall be developed for approval in accordance with the concept plan entitled “Exhibit 7A – Lot Line Adjustment Map” and “Exhibit 7B – Proposed Improvements Map”, dated December 2, 2014 and prepared by Draper Aden Associates. Approval of a site plan is required prior to obtaining a building permit and or issuance of a Certificate of Occupancy for the change in use.
9. No storage containers used for shipping purposes, or truck compartments or trailers shall be stored or otherwise used on the premises.
10. There shall be no outside storage. Materials received at the site shall be stored within the existing structures until a truckload is available for shipment.
11. Exterior lighting shall comply with Section 10-46(9) of the Montgomery County Code.
12. Signage for the site shall be compliant with Section 10-45 of the Montgomery County Code. Banners and/or other signage shall not be installed or mounted on any fence.
13. Occupancy of the security residence shall be limited to no more than four (4) unrelated and six (6) total occupants within the dwelling.
14. As a condition of receiving approval to allow a recycling center at 3431 Radford Road, the owner agrees to submit a letter withdrawing/vacating the Special Use Permit in effect at 2700 Radford Road.
15. Site shall be substantially in conformance with the concept plan submitted with the application materials dated December 2, 2014.

The subject parcel is located at 3431 Radford Road and identified as Tax Parcels No. 90-4-1A, 2A, 90-5-1,2,3,4,5,6,7, 90-5-40, 40A and 40B; Account No. 011646, 019273, 019274, 019275, 019276, 019277, 014010, 014148, 015706, 014011 and 014149 in the Riner Magisterial District (District D).

The property currently lies in an area designated as Village Expansion in the 2025 Comprehensive Plan and Mixed Use in the Plum Creek Village Plan.

This action was commenced upon the application of Montgomery County Board of Supervisors and NRVP&P LLC Properties (Agent: Kendall Clay, Attorney).

This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.

ISSUE/PURPOSE: Approve a rezoning and special use permit application.

JUSTIFICATION:

NRVP&P LLC Properties proposed to move their recycling operation to the former Thompson Chrysler Auto Sales facility located at 3431 Radford Road and vacate their current facility located at 2700 Radford Road. The new site requires a rezoning and special use permit to allow a recycling operation. See TAB H .

B. SUBJECT: RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT – CHANGE THE NAME OF NEW RIVER VALLEY PLANNING DISTRICT COMMISSION TO THE NEW RIVER VALLEY REGIONAL COMMISSION

RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FOR CHANGING THE NAME OF THE NEW RIVER VALLEY PLANNING DISTRICT COMMISSION TO THE NEW RIVER VALLEY REGIONAL COMMISSION**

WHEREAS, The New River Valley Planning District Commission was established by the local governments within the region on September 15, 1969 and chartered the Commission with the aforementioned name; and

WHEREAS, The Commission conducted an assessment of the agency in 2012 which identified eight implementation priorities, one of which included changing the name to the New River Valley Regional Commission; and

WHEREAS, The Commission Board of Directors conducted a vote that secured unanimous support at their meeting on October 23, 2014 to pursue changing the name to the New River Valley Regional Commission; and

WHEREAS, Changing the name of the Commission necessitates an amendment to the Commission's Charter which must secure a majority of affirmative support from its members (8 out of 14) to be implemented; and

WHEREAS, The Commission is seeking unanimous support from its members to change the name; and

WHEREAS, The Commission is pursuing the name change to better reflect the overall mission and actions of the agency as a regional body serving the New River Valley, while recognizing the Commission routinely provides services beyond planning to its members, and the name Planning District Commission is often mistaken for local government Planning Commissions; and

WHEREAS, The purpose and function of the Commission will remain unchanged, while the new name offers better alignment with the intended purpose/function of regional collaboration, convening, visioning and service delivery.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the County of Montgomery, Virginia fully supports the New River Valley Planning District Commission changing the name of the agency to the New River Valley Regional Commission.

ISSUE/PURPOSE: Resolution of Support.

JUSTIFICATION: NRVPDC is proposing to change their name to the New River Valley Regional Commission. The name change is being proposed as a result of a recommendation from an agency assessment conducted in 2012. The Commission is requesting the change to better reflect the overall mission and actions of the agency as a regional body of the New River Valley.
