**RESOLUTION APPROVING SECOND MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BY AND BETWEEN THE NEW RIVER VALLEY EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS
REGIONAL AUTHORITY AND COUNTY OF MONTGOMERY, VIRGINIA
FOR SUPPORT SERVICES PROVIDED TO THE REGIONAL AUTHORITY**

WHEREAS, The County of Montgomery, Virginia, the Towns of Blacksburg, Virginia and Christiansburg, Virginia and Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University (“Virginia Tech”) have pursuant to the New River Valley Emergency Communications Regional Authority Act created the Regional Authority to provide the core responsibilities for governance of a consolidated public safety communication center; and

WHEREAS, The County and the Regional Authority entered into a Memorandum of Understanding dated April 25, 2011, whereby the County agreed on an interim basis to provide certain support services for the Regional Authority prior to the Authority becoming operational and moving into their permanent space in the County Public Safety Building; and

WHEREAS, The Regional Authority and the County desire to enter into this Second Memorandum of Understanding to replace the current Memorandum of Understanding dated April 25, 2011, in order to reflect that the County will be providing fiscal as well as Human Resources support services now that the Regional Authority has moved into the County Public Safety Building and become operational.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of Supervisors of the County of Montgomery, Virginia that the Board of Supervisors hereby approves the Second Memorandum of Understanding by and between the New River Valley Emergency Communications Regional Authority and the County of Montgomery, Virginia for support services provided to the Regional Authority; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, By the Board of Supervisors of Montgomery County, Virginia that the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes Christopher A. Tuck, Chair, to execute the Memorandum of Understanding on behalf of the County of Montgomery, Virginia.
