BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of Supervisors of Montgomery County, Virginia that the General Fund was granted an appropriation in addition to the annual appropriation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015, for the function and in the amount as follows:

320 Sheriff County \$30,000

The source of funds for the foregoing appropriation is as follows:

451205 Designated Fund Balance – Facilities & Main. Reserve \$30,000

Said resolution appropriates funds from the Facilities and Maintenance Reserve for the one-time costs of capital maintenance of existing County facilities.

**ISSUE/PURPOSE:** Facilities and Maintenance Reserve appropriation.

**JUSTIFICATION:** This resolution appropriates \$30,000 from the Facilities and Maintenance Reserve to cover the one-time costs of capital maintenance of existing County facilities. The Facilities and Maintenance Reserve currently contains \$1,402,000 in one-time funding to cover the cost of general building and facility repairs that are not considered part of general operations. On September 14, 2014, the jail's commercial hot water heater stopped working and could not be repaired. After the failure, the jail was without hot water. By law, the Sheriff is required to provide hot showers and hot water for the inmates. The unit that needed replaced was a 715,000 BTU unit that has a 90 gallon tank. This resolution provides the funding to cover the cost of the emergency purchase

**1. SUBJECT: REVISIONS TO THE COUNTY'S

REVISIONS TO THE COUNTY'S  
PERSONNEL POLICIES AND PROCEDURES**

BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of Supervisors of the County of Montgomery, Virginia that the Board of Supervisors hereby approve the deletion of Section 4.10, entitled Career Development Increases, Section A, Constitutional Offices/State Agencies, from the County Personnel Policies and Procedures in order that a replacement Career Development program can be developed that is more broadly applicable to all County employees.

ISSUE/PURPOSE: Approve the revisions to the Personnel Policies and Procedures.

JUSTIFICATION: This resolution suspends the Personnel Policies and Procedures Section 4.10 entitled *Career Development Increases, Section A, Constitutional Offices/State Agencies*, pending replacement with a Career Development Program inclusive of all employees under a uniform plan, not just restricted to Constitutional Offices and State Agencies. The new program is being developed with the goal to ensure the opportunity to participate in career development is uniform, fair and equitable among all employee classes. See TAB E.
