**1. SUBJECT: COMMONWEALTH'S ATTORNEY
DOMESTIC VIOLENCE VICTIM GRANT**

BE IT RESOLVED, By the Montgomery County Board of Supervisors that the General Fund was granted an appropriation in addition to the annual appropriation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015 for the function and in the amount as follows:

Said resolution appropriates the Domestic Violence Victim Grant funds.

ISSUE/ PURPOSE: Appropriate grant award.

JUSTIFICATION: The State awarded the Commonwealth's Attorney a grant to provide funding to cover payroll costs associated with domestic violence, sexual assault, stalking and family abuse services. The funds must be used to hire new staff or expand the number of hours worked by currently employed staff. The grant does not require the County to continue supporting the additional payroll costs after the grant funds are expended. No local match is required. This resolution appropriates those funds.

This award covers January 1 through June 30, 2015. Previously, grant funding covered a calendar year. This short period will allow the state to adjust the grant to a fiscal year cycle.

ISSUE/ PURPOSE: Grant appropriation

JUSTIFICATION: The County received an allocation of \$56,000 from 2013 State Homeland Security Program grant funds. These funds will be used to support implementation of homeland security strategies to address the planning, organization, equipment, training, and exercise needs to prevent, protect against, mitigate, respond to, and recover from acts of terrorism and other catastrophic events. No local match funds are required for this grant award.

Said resolution appropriates DMV Stop Fees collected to pay the associated fee to the DMV and Commonwealth of Virginia.

ISSUE/PURPOSE: Appropriate DMV service charges collected.

JUSTIFICATION: The Treasurer's Office issues DMV stops on delinquent taxpayers. This program prevents taxpayers from receiving DMV license renewals until their delinquent taxes are paid to the County. The DMV charges an administrative fee to the County, which the Treasurer's office passes on to the taxpayer. This resolution appropriates funds received to date under this program.

4. **SUBJECT: TREASURER TRANSFER FROM GENERAL CONTINGENCIES FOR BANK FEES (Balance in General Contingencies before approval of this resolution is \$362,789)**

Said resolution transfers funds from General Contingencies to the Treasurer's Office for the costs associated with Union First banking fees.

ISSUE/PURPOSE: Transfer General Contingencies funds.

JUSTIFICATION: This resolution transfers \$18,000 from General Contingencies to the Treasurer's Office for the costs associated with Union First banking fees. Based on the County's new banking services contract with Union First, the County is required to pay for

several banking fees that were previously complimentary under the old contract with Stellar One Bank. These fees were not finalized before the adoption of the FY 15 budget and the Treasurer's Office does not have funds in their budget to cover these expenses.
