COMMUNITY SERVICE CREDIT FOR COSTS PROCEDURES

For those defendants choosing to use community service hours to credit their court obligations, the following procedures shall apply:

NOTE: For those under the supervision of a probation officer and are not currently working community service hours, please see your probation officer for approval of community service locations PRIOR to beginning work.

- 1. Defendant shall provide to the court documentation from the facility or business where they worked a statement on letterhead or other official documentation that includes:
 - a. Name & Date of Birth or Social Security Number (partial is acceptable)
 - b. Date(s) worked
 - c. Total hours worked
 - d. Pay rate for hours worked
- 2. Defendant shall complete the Petition for Community Service Hours to Apply to Costs form.
- 3. Defendant shall provide to the Court proof of any obligations owed in other courts, with restitution and fines, costs, interest, and fees shown separately.
- 4. Defendant shall petition the court for a hearing date on the criminal docket using the courtprovided form.
- 5. Defendant shall discuss with the court at the hearing under penalty of perjury, a payment plan for any remaining balances of restitution or collections fees that are not included, by Virginia Code \$19.2-354, to be paid by community service credit.
- 6. Defendant shall notify the Court of any change in work circumstance, including gaining paid employment.
- 7. Once the defendant is release from incarceration, the defendant can petition to apply community service towards Court fines/costs.
