

Prepare to Vote

Are you registered to vote? Is your voter registration up-to-date? Outdated or incorrect information can cause delays on Election Day. You can check your Voter Registration information or register to vote at <https://vote.elections.virginia.gov/VoterInformation>

There are three ways to vote in the November 3 election:

1. Vote in person on Election Day in the precinct where you are registered.
2. Vote in person at your local Voter Registration and Elections office between September 18 and October 31, Monday through Friday, from 8:30 to 4:30, and Saturdays October 24 and October 31, from 8:30 to 4:30.
3. Concerned about COVID19? Stay home and vote safely. Apply to vote by mail at <https://vote.elections.virginia.gov/VoterInformation> or request an application from your Voter Registration and Elections office. A reason code is no longer required to vote early.

Voters are encouraged to request and vote an absentee ballot by mail.
